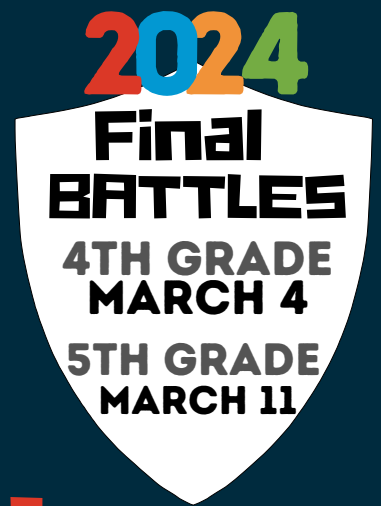


WELCOME TO THE Battle of the Books

READ The books can be read in any order, but the key to success is for every team member to read all the books on your grade's reading list. Copies of the books can be found at AHPL and most of the school libraries. If you are having trouble finding a copy of one of the books, please come talk to us at AHPL. [We can help!](#)

PREPARE Encourage your teammates in their reading. **Take notes while you read!** It's a great way to remember what you've read after your book has been returned to the library. But also, make sure you take your time to ENJOY the stories that are being told. As you get closer to the date of the Battle (and more of your teammates have read the same books), you can start quizzing each other on the books by using your notes to make questions.

PRE-BATTLE Since every team will be invited to participate in the Final Battle, the Pre-Battle is more of a "practice Battle." Each school will be responsible for coordinating a Pre-Battle for their participating teams, so speak to your school's librarian or media specialist about dates and times. **If your school will not be hosting a Pre-Battle,** Team Coaches may contact the library at the email provided below for assistance and instructions.
